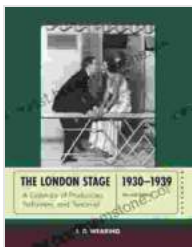

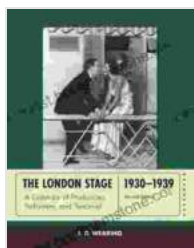

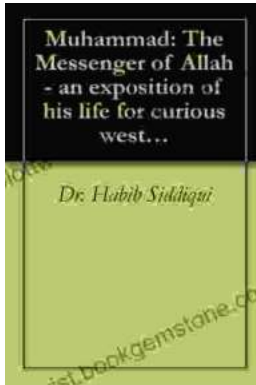


The London Stage 1930-1939: A Calendar of Productions, Performers, and Personnel by J. P. Wearing

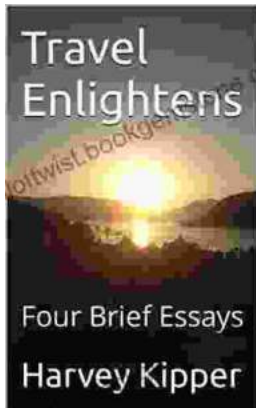
