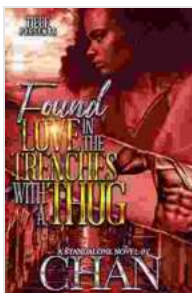

Mary ran to John and threw her arms around him. Tears of joy streamed down her face. John held her close, his own tears mingling with hers.

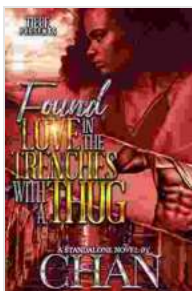
"I'm so glad you're alive," Mary sobbed. "I thought I'd lost you forever."

In the years that followed, John and Mary married and had a family. They lived a happy and fulfilling life together, always grateful for the love that had blossomed amidst the trenches of war.



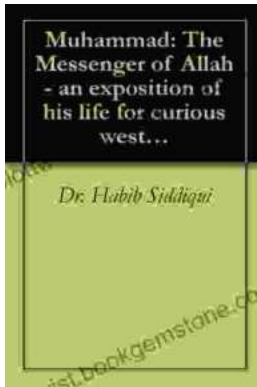

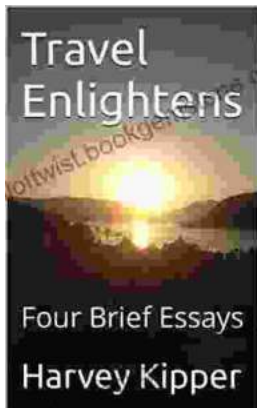
