Traitor Rock (Cadia Book 3) by Justin D Hill

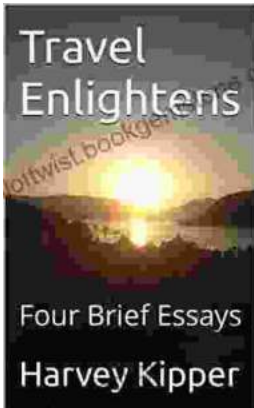
