The Target Books novelizations were generally well-received by fans for their faithfulness to the source material and their ability to capture

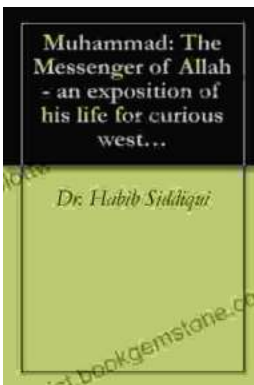

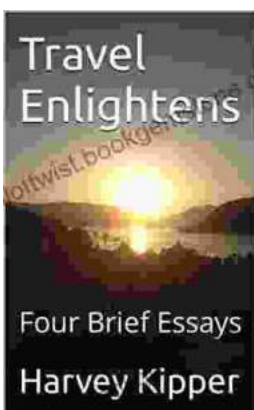
