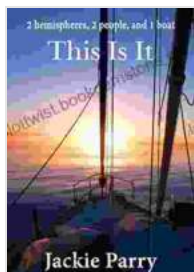

The exhibition is divided into three sections: Hemispheres, People, and Boat. Each section explores a different aspect of the human experience.

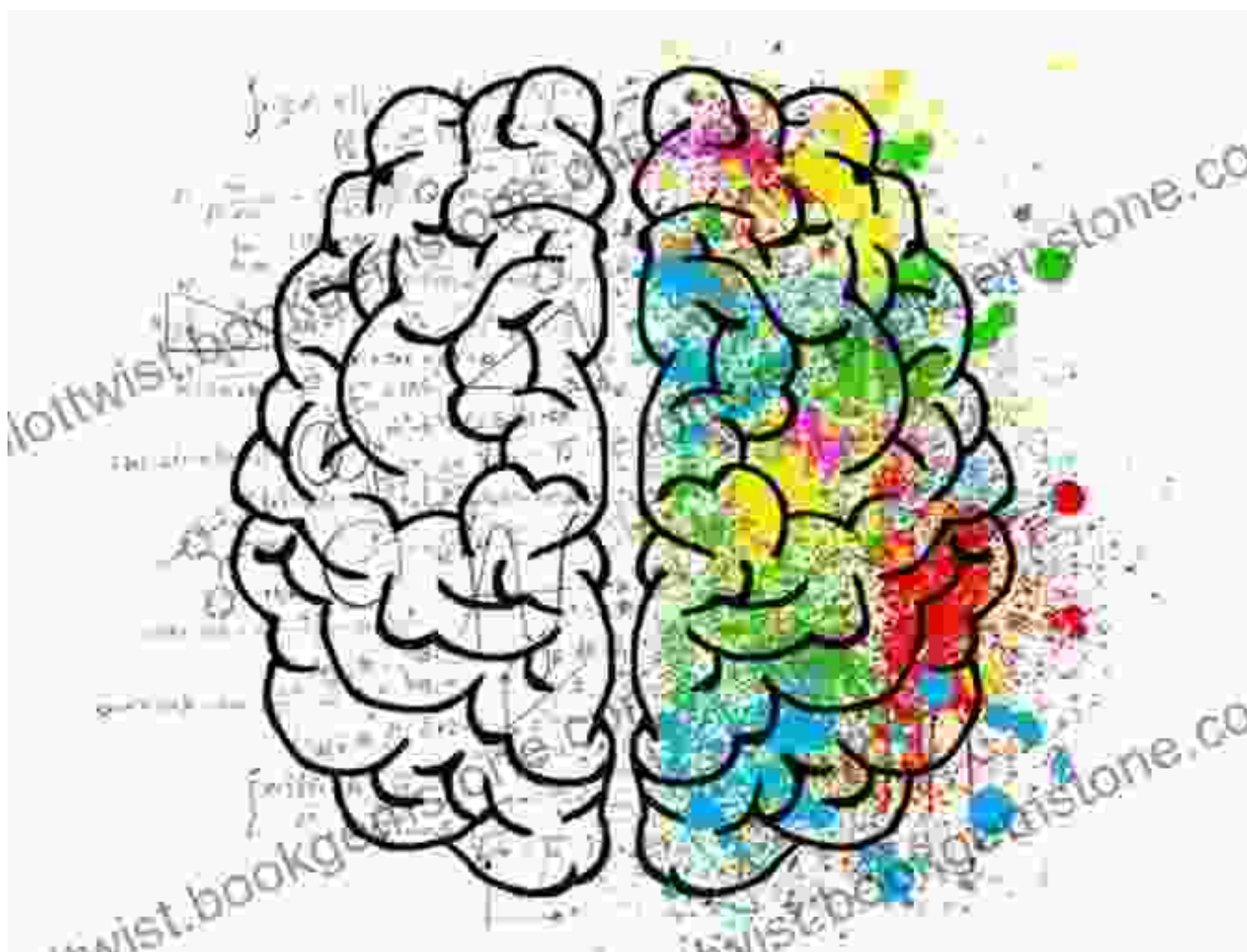
The Hemispheres section features works that explore the duality of the human mind and body. The works in this section are both beautiful and disturbing, and they challenge us to think about the nature of our own existence.

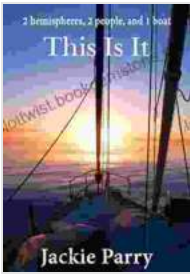

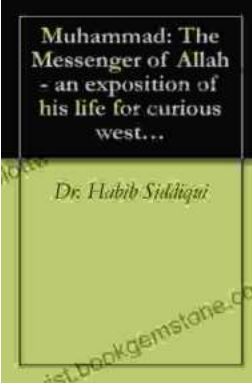

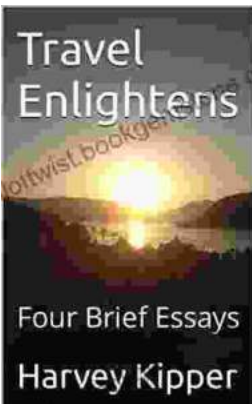
